PREAMBLE

The Oregon Association of Medical Staff Services (OAMSS) is a professional organization with membership throughout the state of Oregon. Most frequently identified as Directors, Managers, or Coordinators, we as members of the health care team, having various responsibilities, which may include:

- + credentialing and privileging of physicians and other health care practitioners;
- + researching and developing privileging criteria for new technology;
- + accreditation compliance
- + administering rules and regulations; and
- + interpreting bylaws.

Medical Staff services professionals are found in hospitals, Managed Care Organizations, Independent Practice Associations, Centralized Verification Organizations, Health Maintenance Organizations, Preferred Provider Organizations, consulting firms, state licensing boards, medical groups, and medical societies to help promote compliance with the myriad of existing health care mandates as well as serving as liaison between the providers and Senior Management.

OAMSS is an active participant in the National Association Medical Staff Services (NAMSS) with a membership of over 5,000 members in 46 states. Through NAMSS we have been invited by the Joint Commission (JC) to serve on the Hospital Accreditation Program Professional and Technical Advisory Committee. In addition, we now hold a seat on the Executive Committee of the National Practitioner Data Bank and have received a four-year appointment to this committee. We also enjoy a close working relationship with the American Medical Association's Organized Medical Staff Section and are represented at meetings of the American Medical Association, Oregon Board of Medical Examiners, Oregon Medical Association and Oregon Association of Hospitals.

The Board of Directors of the OAMSS represents medical staff services professionals and credentialing specialists who have formed a professional association in keeping with the standards and practices of NAMSS.

OAMSS leadership shall seek continuing education accreditation from NAMSS.

OAMSS leadership shall seek approval of the OAMSS bylaws by NAMSS.

OAMSS membership shall endeavor to follow the guidelines, practices and policies of NAMSS.

OAMSS membership shall adhere to the Mission and Code of Ethics of NAMSS.

The mission of the Association Medical Staff Services (OAMSS) is to provide the opportunity for continuing education and to promote the improvement of professional knowledge and skills.

Outgoing President sends signed-off signature card to new Treasurer. New Treasurer obtains signatures of new President and self. New Treasurer sends cards to the bank.

- OAMSS Membership Year Begins January 1 through December 31 of the calendar year

NAMSS FISCAL YEAR

Responsibility: NAMSS Treasurer

- Membership year begins January 1 through December 31 of the calendar year

TITLE: Board of Directors Duties & Responsibilities

POLICY

General Duties of the Board of Directors:

- 1) Provide orientation of OAMSS Bylaws and Policies.
- 2) Perform, oversee, or delegate functions of the office bestowed upon the individual in accordance with their individual duties and responsibilities and assure timely completion of same.
- 3) Work as a team to provide a united approach to attend to the management of the Association; to develop educational opportunities for the membership; and to provide for oversight of the funds entrusted to the Association.
- 4) Assign and monitor task forces or project committees to carry out delegated functions, with regular verbal or written reports to all Board members of the status of each of the task forces or project committees.
- 5) Hold meetings of the Board to set strategies, budgets, assess performances, and make recommendations for future improvements in educational programs, membership maintenance and services to the membership.

The Board should consider meeting before the Spring Conference, during the Spring and Fall conferences if possible, and once before the end of the year or at the beginning of the new year for exchange of Board materials to the newly elected Board members.

- 6) Develop, maintain and recommend amendments to OAMSS Bylaws and adopt Policies and Procedures for OAMSS as may be necessary for the efficient management of the Association.
- 7) Assure Bylaws, continuing education programs and other activities are approved and accredited as appropriate by the National Association Medical Staff Services.
- 8) Assure minutes are recorded accurately at Board and business meetings and presented to the OAMSS membership.
- 9) Assure accurate financial records of the Association funds are maintained and reported at the Spring and Fall conferences and assure the financial transactions are appropriate and in the best interest of the Association.
- 10) Assure each Board member is advised of any pending actions and actions taken by the Board.
- 11) Each Board member assures they inform the President, in a timely manner, of all activities and actions they have individually taken which affect or may affect OAMSS. The information may be communicated either orally or in writing as appropriate.

Responsibilities:

- 1) Annual budget and financial record keeping.
- 2) Annual audit of financial records.
- 3) Education of membership.
- 4) Newsletter and other membership communications.
- 5) Team building with membership.
- 6) Communicating employment opportunities and announcements to membership.
- 7) Liaison with the National Association Medical Staff Services and with Oregon state health related agencies and boards.
- 8) Display booth at the National Association Medical Staff Services
- 9) Letterhead and stationery.
- 10) Marketing of NAMSS certifications.
- 11) Assure a professional and ethical relationship with companies who provide services to OAMSS.
- 12) Provide professional and accurate educational presentations and materials for educational conferences.

POLICY

The President serves as the Chief Executive Officer of the state association and serves as Chairman of the Board of Directors. The term of office is for one year beginning January 1.

The duties of the President include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1) Supervise all activities of the state association, including two continuing education programs.
- 2) Report to the membership at the Spring and Fall Conferences. A copy of this presentation is maintained in the permanent files of the state association.
- 3) Appoint special committees as needed with the approval of the Board of Directors.
- 4) Serve as liaison between the National Association Medical Staff Services and the members of the state association.
- 5) Report activity of the state association to the Western Regional Representative of NAMSS.
- 6) Inform membership of pertinent news from NAMSS through the OAMSS newsletter.
- 7) Submit a report for each issue of the OAMSS Newsletter and Western Regional News publication.
- 8) Keep members of the Board of Directors informed of pertinent news from NAMSS.
- 9) At the Fall Conference, as outgoing President, pass the gavel to the incoming President.
- 10) Manage President's Discretionary Fund in accordance with Policy on same.
- 11) Serve as Program Committee chair for the Spring Conference, customarily held in April or May each year. (Refer to Policy #0035 Conference Planning Procedure)
- 12) Attend the NAMSS annual conference and attend the annual NAMSS Leadership Conference as the representative from the state.
- 13) Perform such other duties as may be necessary to coordinate and advance the association's objectives.

The duties of the President-Elect include, but are not limited to, the following:

1. Serve as Program Committee chair organizing the Fall conference, customarily held in October or November of each year. (refer to Policy #0035 Conference Planning Procedure)
2. Attendance at the annual NAMSS National Conference, based on funds available.
3. Present outgoing President with a Certificate of appreciation, custom framed or engraved on a wall plaque with a gavel at the Fall OAMSS Conference. At the discretion of the Board, purchase a gift of appreciation for the outgoing President.
4. Perform such other duties as may be necessary to coordinate and advance the association's objectives.

- 6) Notify all CEO's and Chiefs of Medical Staff/presidents or supervisors of newly elected OAMSS officers.
- 7) Act as a mentor to the Board.
- 8) Perform other such duties as may be necessary to coordinate and advance the Association's objectives.

- 2) Record proceedings and prepare minutes of the Board of Directors' meetings and promptly distribute to all members of the Board.
- 3) Serve as custodian of all minutes of the OAMSS Board of Directors and OAMSS meetings.
- 4) Perform such other duties as may be necessary to coordinate and advance the association's objectives.

POLICY

The position of Treasurer is an elected office of the organization. The Treasurer serves for a period of two (2) years beginning January 1 and may succeed her/himself.

The duties of the Treasurer include, but are not limited to, the following:

- 1) Maintain the financial records of OAMSS.
- 2) Prepare financial statements for semi-annual conferences and prepare copies for distribution to participants.
- 3) Reimburse expenses in accordance with the policy on "Reimbursement for Travel and Administrative Expenses".
- 4) Provide nametags for participants at each conference. Maintain Name tag covers and ribbons for conferences.
- 5) Prepare budget for review and approval by the Board prior to the Spring Conference.
- 6) Establish a checking account at a discretionary bank, which is both convenient and accessible. Account should be "either/or may draw" with President, President-Elect, Secretary and/or Treasurer. Tax exemption goes to \$25,000 before income tax needs to be paid.
- 7) Assignments as designated by the elected officers of OAMSS.
- 8) Perform such other duties as may be necessary to coordinate and advance the association's objectives.
- 9) In the absence of a delegated Membership Chair, the Treasurer will:
 - a. Provide membership applications for each conference and furnish a copy of the current state OAMSS bylaws to all new members.
 - b. Responsible for contacting and recruitment of new members in their sections of the state.
 - c. Create and/or maintain a database of the OAMSS membership that tracks successive years.
 - d. Provide membership information on a quarterly basis to the Editor for the quarterly newsletter of OAMSS.

- 3) Obtain the scholarship applications and then will forward application packets by blind copy to each member of the Scholarship Committee for evaluation and selection of the recipient(s).
- 4) Adheres to the OAMSS Scholarship Policy criteria and guidelines
- 5) Notifies the OAMSS Board of Directors of the selected candidates chosen by the Scholarship Committee to be recipients of an OAMSS scholarship.
- 6) Promotes the OAMSS scholarship at conferences and Newsletters to keep membership informed of the scholarship opportunities available.

Vacancy of the office of President-Elect shall be filled by mail ballot of the Active membership.

If there is a vacancy in the office of the Past-President prior to the expiration of the Past-President's term, the Board of Directors shall contact the Former Past-President to see if they will assume the duties and authority of the Past-President for the remainder of the unexpired term.

Other vacancies in office may be filled by the Board of Directors for the remainder of the unexpired term.

If in the event, the President or President-Elect cannot attend, the Board shall designate an alternate Board member to represent the organization.

Every opportunity to conserve the expenses of attendance should be made by the individual who attends such as:

- rooming with another and splitting expenses; and
- requesting full or joint sponsorship by their employer.

As a sponsored representative of OAMSS, the individual attending is expected to attend all related functions for State Presidents held during, before or after the NAMSS Annual Conference.

The individuals shall make a report of information learned to the Board and to the entire membership as appropriate.

POLICY

The Board shall budget funds to sponsor the President's attendance at the annual NAMSS States President Retreat. Based on funds available the budgeted amount may include travel, lodging and meals in accordance with the Reimbursement Policy.

If the President is unable to attend, priority of attendance shall be given to the President-Elect. If in the event, the President or President-Elect cannot attend, the Board shall designate an alternate Board member to represent the organization.

Every opportunity to conserve the expenses of attendance should be made by the individual who attends, such as:

- rooming with another and splitting expenses; and
- requesting full or joint sponsorship by their employer.

As a sponsored representative of the OAMSS, the individual attending is expected to attend all related functions at the State Presidents Retreat, held during, before and after the retreat.

The individual shall make a report of information learned to the Board and to the entire membership as appropriate.

POLICY

The OAMSS Board of Directors retains the duties and responsibilities of monitoring and ensuring the finances of OAMSS.

- 1) OAMSS checking account will be maintained by the Treasurer and overseen by the Board of Directors.
 - a. Copies of all debit card and bank statements are to be received by the OAMSS Treasurer.
- 2) All income and expenses will be managed by the Treasurer and reported in an annual statement to the membership of OAMSS at each conference to notify the organization of OAMSS financial position.
- 3) A monthly stewardship report will be forwarded to the President for approval.
- 4) OAMSS will secure a debit card and issue to the Treasurer and President.
 - a. The debit card will be used for the purpose of obtaining products or services directly related to the Board Member's assigned responsibilities to conduct OAMSS business. The debit card will not be utilized for individual purposes for any member of the Board.
 - b. Other expenses such as food and car rental, taxi fare should be paid out directly by the OAMSS board member and reimbursement form should be used. If this presents a financial hardship, a cash advance may be requested and approved by the President for OAMSS board travel expenses that will be incurred for OAMSS business only. The Voucher and Expense forms are located at the end of the policy document.
 - c. Debit card holder is only authorized to use the card for official OAMSS business. All business related expenses that require use of the debit card require prior approval by the President. Documentation and corresponding receipts must accompany the appropriate financial forms within two weeks of utilizing the card. Documentation must include the name of the vendor and names/events attributed to the charge (i.e. restaurant, tax, etc). Misuse or unauthorized use of the debit card will result in immediate revocation of said card.
 - d. Only the identified cardholder shall be authorized to use the OAMSS issued debit card and only for OAMSS related business expenditures, in conformance with OAMSS current reimbursement and travel policies.
 - e. At the end of the Treasurer's term of office, the debit card must be cut up and discarded by the President. At the end of the President's term the debit card will be given to the Treasurer to be cut up and discarded. The Treasurer will request new signature cards from the bank for the incoming Treasurer and new President.

TITLE: Reimbursement for Travel & Administrative Expenses

POLICY

The OAMSS shall reimburse for travel and administrative expenses incurred in conjunction with authorized OAMSS business under the following criteria:

- 1) Authorized individuals include but are not limited to:
 - a) members of OAMSS;
 - b) conference speakers; and
 - c) vendors providing services or products to OAMSS.
- 2) An approved Expense Reimbursement Request form shall be submitted to the current Treasurer of OAMSS for payment. If the expense is from the Treasurer, then the President or President-Elect of OAMSS must co-sign.
- 3) Receipts:
 - a) Expenses over \$25 - receipts from the primary source are required along with an Expense Reimbursement Request form.
 - b) Missing receipts - if a receipt is not available, the requesting individual must have approval from the President or President-Elect of OAMSS confirming an expense over \$15. If the statement is from the President or President-Elect, one may sign for the other.
- 4) Reimbursable expenses for Travel:
 - a) Air Travel: Reimbursement is paid for economy class only. Mileage reimbursed for ground travel to and from the airport shall be reimbursed. Consideration is given to all for Saturday overnight stays to reduce airfare expenditure.
 - b) Ground Travel: Mileage is paid at the current Federal mileage per mile allowance rate. Other ground travel fares incurred are reimbursed with receipt or written explanation attached to the request.
 - c) Lodging: Reimbursement for lodging expenses incurred include the evening before, during, and the last day of the authorized event, including lodging taxes. Additional expenses for individuals who share the room are not acceptable. If charges are shared, then separate reimbursements must be requested.
 - d) Telephone: Only calls associated with OAMSS business are reimbursable.
 - e) Meals: Maximum reimbursement per day is \$60 for all meals. Joint meals shall include the names of all individuals included on the bill. Guest meals should be deducted before submitting receipt for reimbursement.
 - f) Gratuities: Maximum 20% of a food bill and other tips as appropriate.

- 5) Reimbursable other expenses:
 - a) Program Chair or designee: Travel in preparation for conferences shall be eligible for reimbursement with submission of a reimbursement form including an explanation of the place traveled to and the mileage. Reimbursement shall be made in accordance with the Reimbursement Policy.
 - b) Expenses incurred for the Spring and Fall Conferences, including honorariums and travel expenses for speakers.
 - c) Expenses for Board meetings, including mileage/travel reimbursement.
 - d) Expenses incurred for producing and distributing the OAMSS Newsletter.
 - e) Incidental expenses in the general operation of the organization and reported in the semi-annual financial statements.
 - f) Expenses for OAMSS conferences for Board Members.

- 6) Exceptions shall be addressed in writing to the Board of Directors of the OAMSS, who shall have final authority to determine allowed or denied expenses.

Applications are considered complete when the Scholarship Committee has received the application and required supporting documents. (*Refer to attachments 1, 2, 3*)
2. Applicants must provide descriptive information related to the current or planned educational activity for which the scholarship is being sought, and cost of the activity. In addition, applicant must provide the Scholarship Committee proof of enrollment in the current or planned education activity at the time consistent with materials submitted with the application.
3. Applicants must include a typewritten statement detailing past, present, and planned contributions to the medical staff services profession, and include a brief explanation of how the planned activity will benefit applicant both professionally and personally
4. Application deadline is thirty (30) days prior to the applicable event.

The Scholarship Committee will evaluate applications based on the following:

- a. Commitment to educational growth as a medical staff professional;
- b. Demonstration of sincere enthusiasm and support of the goals and mission of OAMSS
- c. Future benefits to applicant and to OAMSS as a result of the scholarship

The Board of Directors shall budget a set amount each year for the OAMSS Scholarship Fund, considering funds are available in the total budget for the year. The Board of Directors has determined that Conference registration and reimbursements (lodging, transportation, and meals in accordance with the Travel Policy) will not exceed \$500.00 for State and \$1000.00 for National Conferences.

The Scholarship Chair will forward application packets by blind copy to each member of the

Scholarship Committee for evaluation and selection of the recipient(s).

The Board of Directors will choose and notify the awardee of the annual scholarship based on the Scholarship Committee's recommendation.

The Scholarship Chair will notify all applicants of the scholarship recipient(s) in writing.
