Committee Charge	Provide oversight to the budget to ensure sound financial practices.
Committee Goals/Responsibilities	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1. Provide review and oversight to the financial reports, investments and records to ensure the organization's continued viability. 2. Provide guidance to the preparation of an annual budget. 3. Provide guidance to the preparation and review of an audit. 4. Recommend an audit firm to the board every 5 years
Committee Composition	<p>The Audit & Finance Committee is composed of a Chair (Secretary/Treasurer) and six (6) NAMSS members who do not currently serve on the NAMSS Board.</p> <p>The Executive Director, the Finance/Accounting Director and the UBS Investment Advisor serve as advisors.</p>
Membership Term	The Chair's term coincides with their term as Secretary/Treasurer of NAMSS. All other committee members serve a one (1) year term and are eligible for reappointment for up to two additional terms (up to three years of service). Terms run January 1 st – December 31 st
Expected Commitment	Time commitment expected for this Committee is 2-3 hours/month including virtual meetings, which are held quarterly.
Selection/ Appointment	Please refer to the Nomination of Board Members policy and Secretary/Treasurer job description for appointment of the Audit & Finance Committee Chair. All other members are selected by the President Elect with input from the Committee Chair. Committee member selections are approved by the Board.
